Dear Parents,

The nurse maintains all **Health Records!** In order to keep a complete and accurate record of all students Health Records, I need parental cooperation in this important matter. This information is contained in the VMA Student / Parent Handbook but since I have not received a lot of the required forms this year, I thought I would provide you with this information as a **reminder**.

The **State of Pennsylvania** mandates the following **Health Requirements** for children of school age who are attending elementary school, high school, both public and private school, and for those entering kindergarten:

NEW ENTRY: (Kindergarten or any New Student from out of state or out of the country).....**Needs:** **Physical Exam (including Health history and allergies)**

Dental Exam

Record of Immunizations

Also **Health Records** from the previous school must be sent to Villa Maria Academy. It is state law that these records be kept at the school the child is now attending!

PHYSICALS needed for:

ALL **6th Graders** and.....

Any girl who will be **participating in any Villa Maria Academy Sports** must have a physical done each year....this will enable them to play any sport thru that school year!

The *Physical* must be *dated* from **January** of the present year!

DENTAL EXAMS needed for : **3RD & 7TH Graders.**

- The girls in **3rd, 6th, & 7th grades** will be given these forms the last week of school. Please put them in a safe place!If misplaced they can be downloaded on the Villa Website (click on downloads and scroll down to appropriate form).

The forms are **due:** **FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL!**
