Dear friends of Villa Maria Academy,

I am proud to present to you this copy of the 2021-2022 Annual Report for Villa Maria Academy. The report summarizes the charitable gifts given to Villa Maria through our two major fund-raising events—the Annual Fund and the Parent Guild (Villa B.A.L.L.). In total, over \$158,000 has been given to Villa Maria in the last year.

Our Annual Fund began in October 2021 and continued to June 2022. The proceeds from the Annual Fund financed enhancements for teaching and learning. Here at Villa Maria Academy, we place great value and emphasis on teacher professional development. Research reveals that the very best professional development programs are those that are continual, take place during the school day, focus on the individual teacher's needs and interests, become a part of the teacher's responsibilities and center on student results. In response to the research, Villa has continued to support an embedded professional development program which is based on individual teacher goals for professional growth. Administration, the instructional technology coach, and school colleagues provide the support for the teacher as she seeks to learn new skills and implement those skills within her classroom. The Annual Fund also provided resources for maintaining our building with the installation of carpeting and the purchase of updated security hardware and software.



YOUR GIFTS IN SUPPORT OF ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND ADVANTAGES FOR OUR STUDENTS

Both teachers and students benefited from the purchase of digital resources and technology hardware which could be used across the curriculum. The SeaPerch program challenged our 8th grade to engineer and test remotely operated underwater vehicles. New equipment was installed in the projection room and in the PreK building. Additional programming, events, and materials augmented the education of each student.

The installation of LED lighting throughout our school brightened our rooms and reduced the cost of electricity and overall energy use. While the upfront expense is higher than usual lighting bulbs, this latest generation lasts longer to withstand frequent switching and is energy efficient. This is a significant savings for our operating budget for many more years.

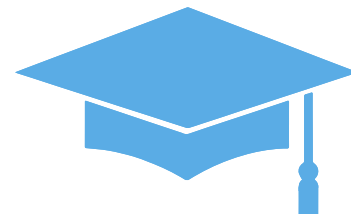

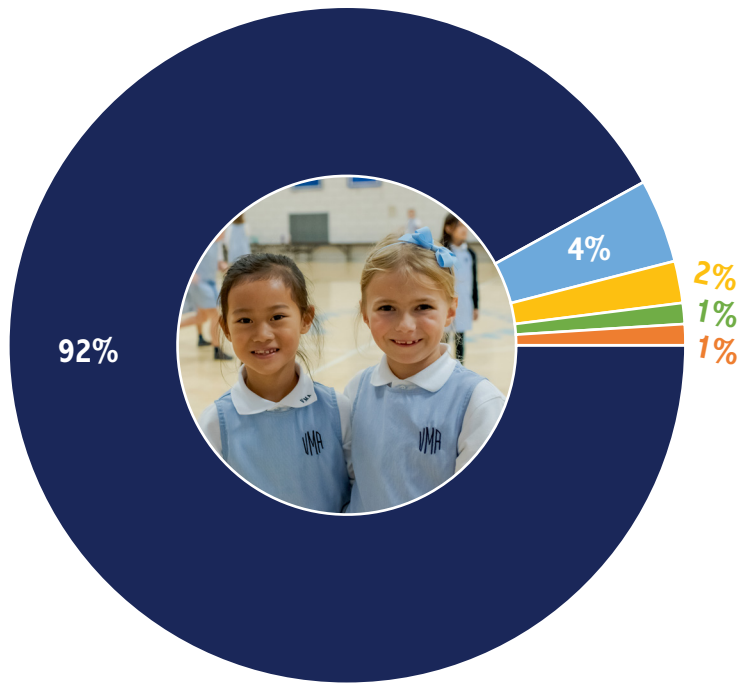

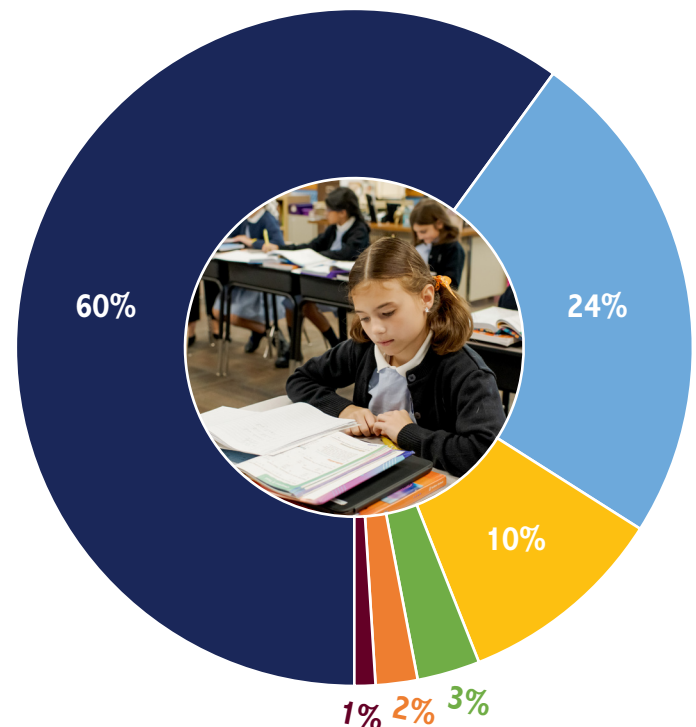
